Jindřichův Hradec, where was our first part of the project, is a small town in the South Bohemian Region of the Czech Republic. It has approximately 22,700 inhabitants. The city castle and palace is the third largest in the country after those in Prague and Český Krumlov. More than 10,000 works of art and a similar number of books may be found there. Jindřichův Hradec's neighbourhood includes sites such as Červená Lhota Castle, the historical town of Třeboň and Stráž nad Nežárkou. The UNESCO World Heritage town of Telč lies 40 kilometers (25 miles) to the east.

What to bring?
